- Parent Survey Update 61 respondents out of 180ish families, shooting for 40% respondent rate. Lots of good information coming in as we think ahead to next year. Themes around Spanish Teacher, new ways to unify the campuses
- Enrollment Contact Invoicing Update About \$14,000 outstanding for SCRIP, including Choice families that need to be removed by Mr. Dempsey.
- Summer Facilities Project Schedule \$10,000 under budget so far on all planned activities
 - i. New signage has been completed on the doors and the Gym/Activity Center.
 - ii. Next up urinal privacy barriers in main floor boys bathroom at Resurrection.
 - iii. This summer the lockers will be removed and put back in by August.
 - iv. New cameras external and internal are being added
 - v. Gym Floor at St. Matts is being refinished as well
