- **Approval October Minutes [Voting Item]**
 - October Minutes – Motion to approve: Katie Denney; second Kerry Kratzke; motion carries
- **Financial Report - Rob**
 - YTD through 9/30 - Fundraising about 19K,
 - Site Specific Expenses at about 13K.
 - Auction Specific Income - 11K
 - Buyout Income at \$7500
 - BrandTek Expense - \$790, likely teacher spirit shirts
- **Principal's Report - Francis**
 - WRISA Accreditation Visit Recap (October 20-22, 2025)
 - i. 7 year review about where we were to where we are
 - ii. Reviewed on 4 Domains from Education to Catholic Identity
 - 1. Were scored 3/4s on all categories, large improvement over last accreditation process
 - iii. Opportunities
 - 1. Improve Mission Statement
 - Use the Wolves statement as the Mission Statement and how we will work to update it; Ask to include education as part of it
 - 2. Development of onboarding process for teachers
 - 3. STEAM curriculum and after school activities
 - 4. Assistant Principal needs to be put in place
 - iv. Plan to begin preparing much sooner for the next accreditation, as this was a very heavy lift
 - v. Will be publishing in a coming Newsletter, reports will also be reviewed by GRACE and the Diocese
 - Enrollment Update - 309 students, 3 newest are due to relocation (4K, 3, 4), 1 student will also be leaving due to relocation
 - Safety Updates & Survey Results
 - i. Discussed but will disclose externally in the future
 - ii. More to come
 - Middle School Assembly Awards
 - i. Wolfies are used at the Elementary school
 - ii. New incentive program for all Middle school students
 - 1. Monthly - 3 Kids are recognized (Welcoming Others, Loving Vibrantly, Encouraging Service as Disciple of God)

- **New Business**
 - Facilities Projects & 2025-2027 Planning - Justin, Francis & Heather
 - i. Safety and Security
 - 1. Resurrection Entry and Security Cams
 - Requested 7K-10K from Grace and 10K from Capital Campaign
 - Resurrection Parish will also help to take on some of the cost
 - i. \$47K, all in cost
 - 1. Parish also willing to fund at least 7K
 - 2. Likely about 20K needed from SAC
 - ii. Joe has worked to contact people around Sound Systems in the gym and the new playground
 - 1. 5000 to sound system confirmed by a donor
 - Moving forward
 - Also wrote a 20K charitable trust request
 - 2. 10000 to playground, once 50000 has been invested
 - Hoping to break ground in 2027
 - Capital Campaign
 - iii. Motion made to increase the facilities budget to 145K to include Sound System and Security Update (knowing we should see 30K+ in Campaigns, Donations per Francis) to cover the bills by Matthew Dufek and seconded by Katie Denney....motion passes with descent and discussion occurring
 - All Campus Opportunity from Mrs. Gracer & Mrs. Burns - Heather
 - i. Read-a-thon - Requesting \$204.78
 - ii. Agreed to move forward with this within the existing budget
 - Extra Curriculars Update - Heather
 - i. Starting in January
